Short version

Be considerate, respectful, collaborative. Refrain from bullying or harassment. Treat everyone with dignity. Raise any concerns with the event organiser or moderator.

Long version

The Digital Hub is committed to providing a friendly, safe and welcoming environment for all, regardless of gender (including gender identity), civil status, family status, sexual orientation, age, disability, religion, race, neurodiversity, physical appearance, body size, and membership of the Traveller community. This list is not intended to be exhaustive, so we ask you to treat everyone with dignity.

Be considerate, respectful and collaborative.

- Mute your mic and video unless presenting.
- Do not interrupt or speak over other presenters.

Respect everyone's privacy and treat personal data with the utmost sensitivity.

- Do not take pictures or record other participants without their permission.

Refrain from bullying or harassment.

- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory or harassing behaviour and speech.
- Consider what you are saying and be mindful of language usage.
- Treat everyone with dignity.
- If you are made feel uncomfortable or notice someone else is being harassed, or is in distress, please alert the organiser or moderator of this event.
- Participants will be asked to stop any harassing behaviour.
- If there is sustained harassment, discrimination, or disruption The Digital Hub will remove the participant from the event.
